Receive minimum wage while attending school and gaining work experience!

Program Length: 24 weeks

Program Description:

12 weeks of Group-Based Employability Skills

Receive the Alberta minimum wage while you learn about employability skills, the hidden job market, job search techniques, time management, conflict resolution, workplace safety, creating resumes and cover letters, interview basics, financial literacy, computer skills, etc.

12 weeks of Paid Work Experience

Work 30 hours per week for 12 weeks with your host company and gain valuable industry experience.

Ongoing Career Counselling

Each student will receive resources and support throughout the in-class component of the program, as well as continued guidance from program staff after work placement begins.

Eligibility/Requirements:

- Between 15 and 30 years of age (inclusive)
- Legally entitled to work in Canada
- Being a Canadian Citizen, Permanent Resident or Refugee
- Not currently receiving Employment Insurance (EI)
- Actively looking for employment or willing to go back to school
